Key priorities for 2020-21

We aim to ensure the gaps in learning from the Covid-19 Lockdown (March 2020) are addressed. Children who are not reaching their personal targets are supported and targeted for specific intervention in order to ensure they remain on track to do so. Particularly the attainment of our pupils in the core subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths are addressed. Catch-up funding is based on pupil numbers and **£9,334**, is expected in 2020-21. (Half pre-April and half post-April)
