



Pupil Premium Grant Planned Spend

The Pupil Premium is an allocation of additional funding given to schools in order to support specific groups of children who are vulnerable to possible underachievement.

The intended effect of this funding is to accelerate progress and raise attainment in all curriculum areas, particularly in mathematics, reading and writing and close the gap between our disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged learners.

Additional teacher to support Year 6 pupils	To provide interventions to targeted children in the core areas. To provide additional support to Year 6 pupils- particularly disadvantaged pupils.	£19,715

Curriculum support	-To subsidise the cost of school trips -To subsidise the cost of outside speakers/visitors to school	£6,000
Basic Needs Support	-To offer support for pupils in our before and after school provision- Fabbs -To cover the cost of school snack for disadvantaged pupils. (Magic breakfast subscription) -To cover the cost of school uniforms and PE kits for disadvantaged pupils.	£8,000 £500 £1000
Attendance support Officer	-To improve the attendance of disadvantaged pupils by working with families to support them getting their child(ren) into school- home visits, visits in school.	£2000 per annum + Admin hours £1976
