Art

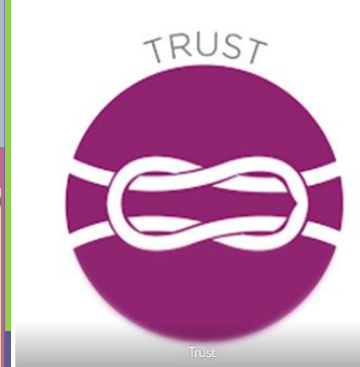
Paper art:

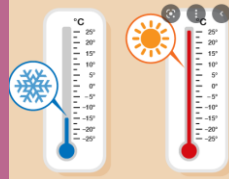
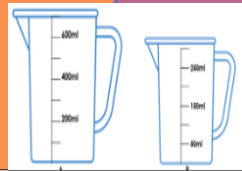
Mathematics
